# OBJECTIVES

## **Programmatic objectives:**

- + Temporary platform for art, design, fashion, photography, music
- + 8 week programm with exhibition, presentations, workshops, events, networking
- + Presentation of and exchange with current Ukrainian creative and cultural producer
- + Series of charity events and donations to humanitarian foundations

## **Charity objectives:**

- + Short-term emergency aid for Ukrainian creative and cultural producers
- + Medium-term support for the establishment of a new permanent platform for Ukrainian art and design in Berlin
- + Long-term support in building up a new economic existence for the creative and cultural producer in Germany

# CHARITY FOUNDATIONS



Assistance is provided to Mariupol residents who left the city after March 15 and are now in the territory controlled by the Ukrainian government and army.



Humanitarian aid with food and medicines in the city of Kharkiv.



A shelter and a medical center for animals from hot spots (Irpın, Bucha, Hostomel).

A part of the income from the sale of the designers' and artists' works will be transferred to the following organizations and initiatives.



A project that helps Ukrainian women who find themselves in crisis situations.



Provide humanitarian assistance to the civilians, particularly those who are on the verge of survival today: single mothers, elderly lonely people, bedridden and disabled children.



The event is hosted and promoted by CLB Berlin. CLB Berlin is an independent exhibition space for art, science, urbanism and digitalisation at Moritzplatz in Berlin Kreuzberg. The gallery is located on the ground floor of the Aufbau Haus and offers around 120 square meters of space for exhibitions and events.
